



## VELEVET APPLE

**V**elvet Apple is supposed to have originated in Philippines. It can be grown as a shade tree, as part of landscaping and for fruits in orchards and homesteads. Flowers appear axially or on the terminal portion of branches and profuse fruition may be expected if pollinating agents like honeybees are available in good numbers. Fruits on maturity will have the size of an apple and will be reddish orange in colour. Outer skin looks like a velvet, and has a scent similar to that of cheese. The inner edible pulp like portion is cream in colour, is odorless and contains 3-4 seeds.
